

# Sam Crosby honored by Alabama State Bar

Baldwin County Attorney Sam Crosby received the Judge Harold Albritton Pro Bono Leadership Award during the Alabama State Bar Swearing-In Ceremony for newly admitted Alabama lawyers in Montgomery on Oct. 24. The ceremony was presided over by the Alabama Supreme Court.

The Albritton Award honors lawyers whose outstanding leadership has significantly impacted pro bono legal services to the poor in Alabama.

During his term as Alabama

State Bar president in 2007-08, Crosby championed the cause of legal services for the poor. He regularly volunteers his time with the South Alabama Volunteer Lawyers Program, based in Mobile, which provides free civil legal services to low-income clients in Baldwin, Mobile, Clarke and Washington counties.

Crosby is a member of the law firm Stone, Granade, & Crosby, which employs 12 lawyers and maintains three offices in Baldwin County.
